## For Immediate Release:

CollegeBound's program IMPACT on Inner City Children over the past year:

- 2,132 students accepted into a four year or two year college
- 19 high schools experienced a National Association of College Admission Counseling (NACAC) regionally sponsored college fair
- 8,600 students attending college fairs at their high schools
- 1,080 sophomores, juniors and seniors taken to tour colleges and universities through the mid-Atlantic region
- 2,300+ students took advantage of one-on-one college advising services
- Over \$104,000 in student college application fees covered by CollegeBound
- \$40,555 in student college admission test fees (SAT/ACT) covered by CollegeBound

*For every \$1 in grant aid awarded a college student by CollegeBound, an additional \$10 of college education costs are leveraged through CollegeBound's college advising program*
