In addition to the winning students, three teachers won a pizza party for their class for being the classes that went above and beyond in the number of creative entries submitted. Those teachers are Mrs. McNeal-Smith from Green Street Academy, Mr. Shoales from Highlandtown Elementary/Middle School, and Mr. Thurmon from Margaret Brent Elementary/Middle School. All winning students and teachers will be invited to the aquarium for the awards ceremony. They will also receive admission to the aquarium for the day and a 4D movie.

Winners were gifted college paraphernalia to continue their curiosity and aspirations of attending college.
